


Steps to Generate TurboMeeting MSI Installer

Download MSI Wrapper free version from following link:


Install MSI Wrapper on windows PC.

Step 1: Open MSI Wrapper and click on Next button on Welcome page.




Step 2:

- Provide the path for TurboMeetingStarter.exe in Setup executable input file name field.
- Provide the path for output msi file in MSI output file name field.
- Click on Next button



Step 3:

- Provide application id in Application id field.
- Click on Create New Button it will generate Upgrade code
- Click on Next button
